Daniel Vest of 234 CR 378, has requested his meter be tested because of excessively high water usage. A motion was made by Alderman Long, seconded by Alderman Jackson and unanimously approved for Galen Shumaker to test the water meter and report back to the Board on findings.

A motion was made by Alderman Jackson, seconded by Alderman Long and unanimously approved to pay bills as presented.

- Paperwork completed on 2% tourism tax passed with 77% in favor
- Washington St Suncoast finished lining the pipes. Subcontractor scheduled to come week of Dec 2 to work on Peavy. They will also be cleaning up and filling in the holes around the drain on Washington St.
- Gas leak at Town Hall. Replaced faulty gas heater and repaired valve.
- Garden Club will be selling tickets to the Carrollton Christmas Open House at Town Hall on December 10, 2019.
- Denise Grones resigned from Historic Preservation Commission; therefore the vacancy will be advertised in The Conservative.
