Be it remembered the Board of Alderman met in regular session on Tuesday, March 4, 2025. In the absence of Mayor Lee, Co-Mayor Gee called the meeting to order, Alderman Milton opened with prayer.

The first order of business was a motion by Alderman Milton, seconded by Alderman Long, and unanimously approved accepting the meeting Agenda.

A motion was made by Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Milton, and unanimously approved to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the previous and accept as emailed and printed.

Galen Shumaker, the water operator spoke next.

- If it doesn't rain or get really cold, they may get the limbs cut and trimmed at the water tank.
- Galen has purchased a spider basket, which will hoist them up the elevated tanks by cable instead of using the stairs. A cable will need to be purchased and stays with each tank for the basket to be used. No price was given at the time for the cable.

A motion was made by Alderman Milton and seconded by Alderman Long and unanimously approved to have Galen purchase the cable needed to use the spider basket at the elevated tanks.

A motion was made by Alderman Milton, seconded by Alderman Long, and unanimously approved to pay the usual and customary bills as presented.

- One irregular bill was brought forth. H&H Construction repaired the Edwards Driveway, which was caused by the Towne's Construction work previously done.

A motion was made by Alderman Milton, seconded by Alderman Long, and unanimously approved to pay H&H Construction out of the Drainage Fund.

Unfinished Business:

- H&H Construction brought forth a proposal of four jobs for the Town of Carrollton. See attached.

A motion was made by Alderman Long and seconded by Alderman Williams, and unanimously approved the proposal from H&H Construction.

New Business:

- As of March 3, 2025, Arlin Pearson resigned from the position of cleaning the Community House.

A motion was made by Alderman Williams and seconded by Alderman Milton to accept Arlin's resignation.

A motion was made by Alderman Williams and seconded by Alderman Milton to hire Mary Corley for the position as the Community House cleaner starting immediately.

Carrollton Planning Committee will again have the Spring event planned for April the 18th. Chick-fil-A will be here again and several activities will be held.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion was made by Alderman Milton, seconded by Alderman Williams, and unanimously approved to adjourn until Tuesday, April 1, 2025.
