**BOARD MEETING**

Tuesday, May 6, 2025

Be it remembered the Mayor and Board of Alderman met in regular session on Tuesday, May 6, 2025. Mayor Lee called the meeting to order and opened with prayer.

The first order of business was a motion by Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Gee, unanimously approved to accept the Agenda for the meeting.

A motion was made by Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Goodman and unanimously approved to dispense with the reading of the minutes from the previous and accept as emailed and printed.

Galen Shumaker, water operator, gave the following reports:

- The meter at the Carroll Academy ballfields is leaking and needs to be replaced. On motion by Alderman Goodman, seconded by Alderman Gee, the Board unanimously approved to purchase the electronic meter at a cost of \$1,600 instead of a \$2,900 compound meter.
- Repairs to the #3 well house have been completed.
- Galen has received a bid for \$19,500 to repaint the booster station tanks.
- We need to replace the communication controls for the elevated tank and the well as the current control is not turning on the well when the tank gets low.
- The matter of the Big Sand Gym meter was tabled until the situation could be further researched.

A motion was made by Alderman Long, seconded by Alderman Goodman, and unanimously approved to pay the usual and customary bills as presented.

Mayor Lee gave the following reports:

- I have been awarded the LET's Scholarship for the annual conference, saving us \$350 on the registration. I have also submitted the Carrollton Planning Committee & its events for the Community Spirit Award.
- The Big Sand Backyard BBQ event, one of the Planning Committee's events, will be held May 24, from 9am to 3 pm. We are working with the Sheriff and will close the streets as usual.
- The Antiquities Society has been awarded a Certified Local Government Grant to re-roof the Conservative building. They will pay Dixie Roofing and submit the invoices to MDAH. Because the Town is the CLG, MDAH will send their reimbursement check to us to reimburse them.

- Mike Rozier has given Doyle a price of \$3,000 for 2 lights and all materials to light the water tower with 2 lights. [Not sure what all materials includes.] We have a recommendation on Cooper lights from Lighting Solutions in AL. They sell through Agilix in Grenada. Lighting Solutions is going to get the price from Agilix for us. I have requested an estimate from Entergy for the cost of usage.

Unfinished Business: -

- On motion by Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Goodman, and approved unanimously by the Board to reimburse expenses for waterline locates and line repairs caused by Delta Electric Lightspeed boring crews to our marked lines from the HB 603 funds as they are legitimate expenses.

New Business:

- On motion by Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Gee, the Board voted with no opposition to approve the proposals for H&H Services to clear the debris from the ditch in front of Stanhope to prevent future issues with clogged storm drains and in front of Bill Lord's house to prevent mosquito breeding. The cost for both projects will be \$2,600.
- On motion by Alderman Goodman, seconded by Alderman Gee, the Board voted with no opposition to pay Gary Bankston for the drainage work on Peavy Street in the amount of \$1500.
- On motion by Alderman Long, seconded by Alderman Gee, the Board voted with no opposition to purchase mulch for the Community House beds, not to exceed \$125.
- On motion by Alderman Goodman, seconded by Alderman Long, the Board unanimously voted to table the discussion on College Street for further information.

There being no further business to come before the Board a motion was made by Alderman Goodman, seconded by Alderman Gee, and unanimously approved to adjourn until Tuesday, June 3, 2025.

Following the Town Board meeting, the Zoning Board was called into session to discuss the following Building Permit Applications.

- Carroll Academy's request for the canopy for the playground equipment was approved but the late fee was not discussed. On motion by Board Member Williams, seconded by Board Member Gee, and unanimously approved by the Board, the late fee of \$10.00 per day from the day supplies were delivered to the date of the application is due.
- Regarding the question from Headmaster Daves, each new project must be handled through the same process as the canopy. However, several projects, such as projects relating to the ballfields can be grouped together into one application. The projects can also be divided into work that will be done during a specific school year.
- Regarding the application from Tax Collector Tammy Inmon for replacing front door on the front office, Chairman Goodman said that this item would not be included because of the cost.
